- Demographic Survey

Hard copies will be distributed after the homily at each Mass the weekend of Oct 4-5; there will be time (about 3 minutes) to complete the surveys. Hard copies will also be available after each Mass the following weekend, Oct. 11-12. QR codes will be prominently placed around the parishes as well as in the bulletin and on social media.

- A subgroup will review all the responses and will prepare a report for parishioners that will be published in the bulletin. Thank you to Pat, Janina and Claudia for heading this up.
- The survey will be publicized in the bulletin, websites, social media and pulpit announcements to prepare the parishioners and get as much participation as possible.
- What Are Our Gifts?
  - Gina suggested that we start the listening sessions and/or surveys at the beginning of November. Discussion about how to encourage parishioner participation ensued. This will be further discussed at the next PFAC meeting in October.
- Baseline Viability Metrics
  - Gina reminded the council that the parish viability metrics discussed a few months ago should be presented to the parishioners. These metrics include Evangelization, Utilization, Staffing, Buildings and Financial viability. A subgroup should be formed to work on this.
